Rules / Eligibility

Entry fee is \$20.00 to enter for one dish/entry only. Either "Entrée" or "Side" Dish. All entry fees will go to the Bing Rooming House Museum Endowment Fund. All applications and entry fees must be submitted at the same time by Friday September 7, 2018. We will be accepting entries starting August 1, 2018. Participants must be 18 years of age.

Community Competitors must be set up by 12:30p.m. and must remain on site through the duration of the event (5:30p.m.). Judging categories will be rendered by public vote and VIP guests. The general public will purchase armbands for \$10.00. Each competitor is required to have 200 servings using the 3 oz. containers provided by the event organizers for public tasting. Announcement of competition winners will take place at 4:30 p.m. on stage during the event.
